**AUGUST** Regional Unemployment Rate (not seasonally adjusted)

- Represents 209,340 people looking for a **new job**
- DOWN from a peak of 14.3% in April 2020
- DOWN from 6.8% last month
- **DOWN** from 8.1% from last year
- **HIGHER** than the statewide rate of 5.3%
- **HIGHER** than the national rate of 5.3%
- Monthly Change Employers in the Houston-Galveston region ADDED 4,800 jobs in August 2021
   Job loss in Government of -7,700 was tempered by gains in Professional & Business services of 5,500 as well as Education & Health Services with an increase of 4,000 jobs.
- Year-over-Year Change Total Nonfarm employment was UP 4.8%

Top-3 Drivers of year-to-year Job Growth in August

- Leisure and Hospitality: 54,500
- Professional and Business Services: 24,900
- Trade, Transportation, and Utilities: 24,300

## COVID-19

The Houston area has regained roughly 60% of the jobs lost in March and April 2020 due to the pandemic

The Texas Workforce Commission will release September 2021 employment figures on October 22, 2021.
