DECEMBER Regional Unemployment Rate (not seasonally adjusted)

- Represents 168,216 people looking for a **new job**
- DOWN from a peak of 14.3% in April 2020
- DOWN from 5.1% last month
- **DOWN** from 7.6% from last year
- **HIGHER** than the statewide rate of 4.3%
- **HIGHER** than the national rate of 3.7%

Monthly Change - Employers in the Houston-Galveston region ADDED 20,400 jobs in December 2021

- Top-3 Drivers of month-to-month Job Growth in December:
 - Trade, Transportation, and Utilities: 7,900
 - Leisure and Hospitality: 3,700
 - o Construction: 3,200

Year-over-Year Change – Total Nonfarm employment was UP 5.1%

- Currently 10 out of 11 sectors show growth year-to-year
 - Professional and Business Services saw the largest growth over the year at 30,300 jobs

COVID-19

- The region has recovered 90 percent of the jobs lost over March and April of 2020
- Service sector workers can apply for childcare scholarships that cover all tuition and fees for a full year.
