Current Employment Overview



On August 21, 2020, the Texas Workforce Commission released employment statistics for **July 2020.** Our detailed regional report for researchers and analysts is at http://www.wrksolutions.com/LocalStats. Below are highlights.

JULY Regional Unemployment Rate (not seasonally adjusted)

- Represents 319,349 people looking for a new job
- **DOWN** from a recent peak of 14.3% in April
- DOWN from 9.7% last month
- **UP** from 4.1% from last year
- HIGHER than the statewide rate of 8.2%
- LOWER than the national rate of 10.5%
- Monthly Change Employers in the Houston-Galveston region SHED 22,200 jobs in July 2020, which reflects typical seasonal patterns that occur each July. Excluding those effects employers SHED 2,700 jobs

The majority of the 22,000 jobs lost were in Government (i.e. public education), which is in line historically for the month of July

- Year-over-Year Change Total Nonfarm employment was DOWN 6.0%
 This represents a decrease of 188,400 jobs from July 2019 to July 2020
- COVID-19

The Texas Workforce Commission allocated additional childcare funds to help more families work and support the local economy.

Individuals receiving unemployment benefits as a result of the pandemic will soon receive an additional \$300 per week.

The Texas Workforce Commission will release August 2020 employment figures on September 18, 2020.
