JULY Regional Unemployment Rate (not seasonally adjusted)

- Represents 233,714 people looking for a **new job**
- DOWN from a peak of 14.3% in April 2020
- **DOWN** from 7.4% last month
- **DOWN** from 11.1% last year
- HIGHER than the statewide rate of 6.0%
- **HIGHER** than the national rate of 5.7%
- Monthly Change Employers in the Houston-Galveston region SHED 7,100 jobs in July 2021
 Job loss in Government of -18,600 was tempered by gains in Professional & Business services of 7,500 as well as Manufacturing with an increase of 3,700 jobs.
- Year-over-Year Change Total Nonfarm employment was UP 4.7%

Top-3 Drivers of year-to-year Job Growth in July

- Leisure and Hospitality: 63,500
- Trade, Transportation, and Utilities: 28,500
- Professional and Business Services: 19.900
- COVID-19

The Houston area has regained roughly 50% of the jobs lost in March and July 2020 due to the pandemic.
