**JUNE** Regional Unemployment Rate (not seasonally adjusted)

- Represents 336,795 people looking for a **new job**
- **DOWN** from 13.9% last month
- **UP** from 4.0% from last year
- **HIGHER** than the statewide rate of 8.9%
- LOWER than the national rate of 11.2%

- Monthly Change Employers in the Houston-Galveston region ADDED 55,000 jobs in June 2020
  Over half of the monthly gains were in Leisure and Hospitality
- Year-over-Year Change Total Nonfarm employment was DOWN 5.6%
  This represents a decrease of 175,900 jobs from June 2019 to June 2020
- COVID-19

The additional \$600 weekly unemployment compensation from the CARES Act is scheduled to end effective July 25, 2020.

The Texas Workforce Commission will release July 2020 employment figures on August 21, 2020.
