MAY Regional Unemployment Rate (not seasonally adjusted)

- Represents 463,133 people looking for a **new job**
- **DOWN** from 14.3% last month
- **UP** from 3.4% from last year
- **HIGHER** than the statewide rate of 12.7%
- **HIGHER** than the national rate of 13%

- Monthly Change Employers in the Houston-Galveston region ADDED 73,800 jobs in May 2020
 Over half of the monthly gains were in Leisure and Hospitality
- Year-over-Year Change Total Nonfarm employment was DOWN 7.2% This represents a decrease of 228,100 jobs from May 2019 to May 2020
