# **Current Employment Overview**

**NOVEMBER** Regional Unemployment Rate (not seasonally adjusted)

- Represents 178,163 people looking for a **new job**
- DOWN from a peak of 14.3% in April 2020
- **DOWN** from 5.4% last month
- **DOWN** from 7.9% from last year
- **HIGHER** than the statewide rate of 4.5%
- **HIGHER** than the national rate of 3.9%

## Monthly Change – Employers in the Houston-Galveston region ADDED 33,100 jobs in November 2021

- Top-3 Drivers of month-to-month Job Growth in November:
  - Trade, Transportation, and Utilities: 16,800
  - Mining and Logging: 4,300
  - Education and Health Services: 4,100

### Year-over-Year Change – Total Nonfarm employment was UP 4.8%

- Currently 9 out of 11 sectors show growth year-to-year
  - Trade, Transportation, and Utilities saw the largest growth over the year at 26,200 jobs

#### COVID-19

- The region has recovered 80 percent of the jobs lost over March and April of 2020
- Service sector workers can apply for childcare scholarships that cover all tuition and fees for a full year.
