**SEPTEMBER** Regional Unemployment Rate (not seasonally adjusted)

- Represents 335,536 people looking for a new job
- **DOWN** from the pandemic peak of 14.3% in April
- **UP** from 8.1% last month
- UP from 4.1% from last year
- **HIGHER** than the statewide rate of 7.7%
- **HIGHER** than the national rate of 8.3%
- Monthly Change Employers in the Houston-Galveston region ADDED 20,300 jobs in September 2020.

The primary drivers of this August's growth were increases in Government; Leisure and Hospitality; and, Mining and Logging.

## Year-over-Year Change – Total Nonfarm employment was DOWN 5.1%

Currently, 9 out of 11 sectors show declines in year over year employment
