**SEPTEMBER** Regional Unemployment Rate (not seasonally adjusted)

- Represents 190,991 people looking for a new job
- DOWN from a peak of 14.3% in April 2020
- **DOWN** from 6.1% last month
- **DOWN** from 9.4% from last year
- **HIGHER** than the statewide rate of 4.9%
- **HIGHER** than the national rate of 4.6%

#### Employers in the Houston-Galveston region ADDED 27,300 jobs in September 2021

- Government + 22,500
- Professional & Business Services + 8,100

#### Year-over-Year Change – Total Nonfarm employment was UP 5.1%

- > Currently 10 out of 11 sectors show year-over-year growth.
- Construction is down 500 jobs to prior year

- > The Houston area has regained roughly 70% of the jobs lost in March and April 2020 due to the pandemic
