EMPLOYMENT RISES SLIGHTLY IN SEPTEMBER

Service Industry workers eligible for childcare scholarship from Workforce Solutions

(HOUSTON) Privately-owned companies in the Houston area hired nearly 5,000 people in September according to numbers released this morning by Workforce Solutions. Cyclical hiring in local government tacked on an additional 22,500 jobs as educators and support staff returned to the classrooms, for a total net gain of 27,300 jobs.

"We always see what appears to be a rather robust month of job growth in September due to the rehiring of public school and university staff furloughed during the summer months; but when we remove this sector, overall hiring was rather weak," said Workforce Solutions principal economist Parker Harvey, noting that employment in August was revised downward by 3,200 versus the original estimate of 4,800.

Unemployment in the Houston area fell by 0.6% in September to a not-seasonally adjusted average of 5.5%.

Service industry workers, including those employed by restaurants and bars, retailers, and the entertainment and recreation industry, are now eligible for a scholarship that covers a full year of childcare expenses. "We want to give a boost to those businesses struggling to recruit and retain workers," said Michelle Castrow, a manager at the regional workforce development agency.
