AUGUST Regional Unemployment Rate (not seasonally adjusted)

- Represents 163,110 people looking for a **new job**
- DOWN from a peak of 13.3% in April 2020
- **UP** by 0.2%from last month
- DOWN from 6.3% from last year
- HIGHER than the statewide rate of 4.2%
- **HIGHER** than the national rate of 3.8%

Monthly Change – Employers in the Houston-Galveston region ADDED 5,400 net jobs in August 2022

- Top-3 Drivers of month-to-month Job Growth in June:
 - Leisure & Hospitality +6,000
 - Professional and Business Services +5,300
 - Education and Health Services +3,700

Year-over-Year Change – Total Nonfarm employment was UP 6.2%

- This represents 191,900 more jobs compared to this period last year
- Currently 10 out of 11 sectors show year-to-year growth. Only Government sector in Houston showed a
 decrease in jobs compared to this month in 2021.

COVID-19

• Total Nonfarm employment for the Houston area stands at 3,273,100, which now exceeds the February 2020 pre-pandemic level of 3,192,200.
