## **Current Employment Overview**

**OCTOBER** Regional Unemployment Rate (not seasonally adjusted)

- Represents 144,620 people looking for a **new job**
- DOWN from a peak of 14.2% in April 2020
- **DOWN** by 0.1% from last month
- **DOWN** from 5.4% from last year
- **HIGHER** than the statewide rate of 3.8%
- **HIGHER** than the national rate of 3.4%

### Monthly Change – Employers in the Houston-Galveston region ADDED 32,400 net jobs in October 2022

- Top-3 Drivers of month-to-month Job Growth in October:
  - Trade, Transportation & Utilities (includes Retail) +12,200
  - Government +11.300
  - Professional and Business Services +6,600

#### Year-over-Year Change – Total Nonfarm employment was UP 6.2%

- This represents 184,100 more jobs compared to this period last year
- Currently, 10 of 11 sectors show year-to-year growth

#### COVID-19

• Total Non-farm employment exceeds pre-pandemic levels, meaning that the Houston Gulf Coast region is now home to 3,321,500 jobs.

The Texas Workforce Commission will release October 2022 employment figures on December 16, 2022.
