An associate's degree is necessary to become a respiratory therapist. The average **hourly wage is \$27.02.**

Respiratory therapists generally work in hospitals and nursing homes with patients who are experiencing cardiology or pulmonary dysfunction. They initiate and conduct therapeutic procedures and treatments; maintain patient records; and select, assemble, check and operate equipment.
